SUBMIT ENTRIES

Entries can be submitted on RingRadar.com. Entries will open 6 weeks before the show and will be open until the Sunday before the show. Late fee will apply to entries submitted after the close date.

We have limited entries that are available on a first come first served basis.

SHOW FEES

A FLAT fee of \$280 will be charged per rider.

This includes all office fees, CDFA fees and any other hidden show fees as well as fees to SAHJA and USHJA Outreach programs.

It includes up to 4 classes that must be added by 5pm the day before the show.

Same day scratches are allowed. - Class fees will be forfeited.

No Same Day adds. - Classes are set at 5pm the day before the show.

A late fee of \$25 will be charged for entries submitted after the closing date.

You may scratch your entry until the closing date with no penalty. After the closing date a \$50 penalty will be applied.

Stalls are an additional fee of \$50. Please inquire about availability.

NEW FOR JUNE

After the 4 class maximum: add any SAHJA Medal Class for an additional \$25.

Have a little kid hanging around? Let them do leadline for \$25!

All OPTIONAL classes must be entered by emailing <u>SilverSpurShowSeries@gmail.com</u> after you have submitted an entry into the show.

DIVISIONS

Future Jumpers - Shown in the 65s and 70s.

Kindergarten Jumpers - Shown in the 85s and 90s.

Future Stars - For our future riders (8yo and under) to gain confidence in the show arena.

Walk Trot Poles Division - To be shown at the walk and trot.

Mini Stirrup Division - To be shown at the walk trot and canter and over cross rails.

Trotting is allowed on course for the Mini Stirrup Division and will not be penalized.

Short/Long Stirrup Division - To be shown at the walk trot and canter and over 2' fences. No oxers.

Beginning Low Hunters Division - To be shown at the walk trot and canter and over 2'3" fences.

Low Open Hunters Division - To be shown at the walk trot and canter and over 2'6" fences.

Mod./Performance Hunters Division - To be shown at the walk trot and canter and over 2'9" fences.

Future Stars, Walk Trot Poles and Mini Stirrup divisions all have equitation (judged on the rider) classes where a rider may only be judged on one horse/pony.

Riders are welcome to cross enter into any division under saddle class. The exception is that Future Stars are not allowed to enter classes with a canter.

AWARDS

Ribbons 1st - 6th place, with Championship and Reserve in each division.

A rider must show in at least 2 classes in the division to be eligible for the Championship.

Management reserves the right to split a division if necessary or cancel classes if less than 2 entries.

If there is a tie for Champion, or Reserve, the winner will be decided by the over fences classes.

If you see a great act of sportsmanship please let our management team know. We would like to recognize those that came to help their barn, or a competitor who gave a pep talk to their competition. Not all ribbons are won in the arena.

Year end awards are done by a horse/rider combo for all divisions.



Thoroughbred Incentive Program - Jockey Club T.I.P. registered horses can earn high points at this show!

6 Jockey Club T.I.P High Point ribbons and prizes will be awarded:

Jumper High Point Thoroughbred Low (below .75m):

Classes 10 - 13; Future Jumper Division

Jumper High Point Thoroughbred Intermediate (.80m - .95m):

Classes 20 - 23; Kindergarten Jumper Division

Hunter High Point Thoroughbred Low (below 2'6"):

Classes 50 - 53; Mini Stirrup

Classes 60 - 63; Short/Long Stirrup

Classes 70 - 73; Beginning Low Hunter Divisions

Hunter High Point Thoroughbred High (2'6" and above):

Classes 80 - 83; Low Open Hunter

Classes 90 - 93; Modified/Performance Hunter Divisions.

New for 2024:

Equitation High Point Thoroughbred Award:

Classes 84, 94; SAHJA Mini Medal and Child/Adult Medal.

Green OTTB High Point Award: Ribbons earned in any class at the show count toward this award. Qualified horses are those who raced within 2 years of the current show year (2022 - 2024), or unraced TBs who are 6 years old or younger.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Show Office Hours: Saturday 12 noon - 5 PM Sunday 6:30 AM - End of Show

Hospitality: Food and beverages will be available on site during show hours.

Ribbons are available at the gate during the show.

Flat classes will be pinned in the arena.

All riders must wear ASTM-SEI certified headgear and appropriate attire while mounted; formal show attire is not required.

Hunter/Jumper Tack & Equipment :Judges will follow USEF/USHJA rules for tack and equipment during competition.

Lost & Found: Located at the horse show office during the show. After the show, any lost and found items will be held with BTH Equestrian.

STABLING

Overnight stabling is offered in a limited capacity.

PAYMENT POLICY

A \$50 deposit is due at the time of entry.

Your balance is due when you pick up your show number.

Outstanding balances will be charged to the card on file by noon the day of the show.


Payment is accepted in the form of cash, check or credit card through RingRadar.com.

Any checks returned by the bank will be charged a \$35 penalty in addition to the returned check charges made by the bank.

Equine Health Attestation & Vaccinations

All competitors must carry proof/certification of vaccination for each horse attending the show. Certification/proof of vaccinations may be requested at any time by competition management.

USHJA Outreach Rewards and Awards

Earn points towards year-end rewards and awards with a free USHJA Outreach Membership!

USHJA Outreach Competitions and Classes provide opportunity to earn national recognition in classes from walk/trot to 3'0" in hunter, equitation, and .60m-1.20m in jumper sections at rated and unrated local shows.

Riders and owners of USHJA Outreach registered horses can earn level status and points to redeem at the end of the year for items such as USHJA logo wear, Outreach ribbons or Outreach medallions.

Bronze Level: Riders or horses must earn at least 50-74 points during the competition year

Silver Level: Riders or horses must earn at least 75-99 points during the competition year

Gold Level: Riders or horses must earn at least 100 points during the competition year

New! Exciting year-end awards will be given to trainers, riders and horses.

Trainers—Earn the

leading trainer in your zone
whose riders have earned 100
or more points
cumulatively in USHJA
Outreach Classes.

Riders— In addition to awards and rewards, one high point rider from each Zone will earn a Golden Backstage Pass to participate in the USHJA National Championship Affiliate sections and get exclusive access to free educational sessions and National Championship Grand Prix and Hunter Derby course walks!

Horses—While horse recording and microchipping is not required to participate in Outreach classes, owners wishing for their horses to earn points must have them recorded with USHJA (\$20/annual or \$75/lifetime). Horses will have their Outreach points tracked and ranked within their USHJA Zone and displayed on ushja.org.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations will be enforced for the duration of the show and apply to all competitors, riders and visitors on the property.

- 1. Entries: All riders must complete and return an entry. Entries will be accepted until the closing date. An additional administrative late fees of \$25 per entry will be applied for entries received after the show closing date
- 2. ASTM rated hard hats must be worn by all riders when mounted.
- 3. Waivers must be signed by all riders prior to undertaking any riding. This includes riding in the warm up arenas. For riders under 18, the Waiver must be signed by a parent or guardian.
- 4. Numbers must be worn at all times when a horse is being ridden, exercised or walked.
- 5. Dogs must be on a leash at all times and are not permitted in the arenas or on courses.
- Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, cancel entries, awards or prizes and/or adjust the time schedule, combine, scratch or move classes as necessary without claims or damage.
 All judge's decisions are final.
- 7. Stall use is by reservation only and availability is subject to change. By renting a stall at Silver Spur Ranch, you agree to abide by the stall use policies.
- 8. The following fees are included in your entry fee.
 - a. CDFA Fee: All Competitors will be charged a \$14 CDFA Fee.
 - b. SAHJA Fee: All eligible competitors will be charged \$2 for record keeping.
 - c. USHJA OutReach Fee: All eligible competitors will be charged \$3 for record keeping.
- 9. Schooling: No juniors or amateurs are allowed to school over fences without having a person in charge on the ground.
- 10. Arenas: Competitors are restricted to show arenas and warm up arenas.
- 11. Lunging is permitted in designated lunging areas only. Do not lunge in warm up or show arenas.
- 12. Photo and Video Consent: By competing or attending competitions or events with Silver Spur Show Series, exhibitors and spectators grant permission to the unrestricted rights to use photographs and/or video footage from the horse show for the purpose of promotion of Silver Spur Show Series in various mediums.
- 13. Management and Judges reserve the right to dismiss riders displaying extreme aggression or force, or riders who seem unsafe.
